
• AFTER REMOVING BOTH BACKNUTS ON MIXER VERSIONS 4593HT & HS. PLACE TAP THROUGH WORKTOP HOLES (Ø25MM HOLES) AT 200MM CENTERS (SEE FRONT PAGE FOR DIMENSIONAL POSITION).

- ENSURE ALL BASE SEALS & ROSETTES ARE IN POSITION BETWEEN MIXER AND MOUNTING SURFACE. ENSURE THE MIXER IS ORIENTATED CORRECTLY.
- SECURE TAP MIXER WITH A SUITABLE TAP WRENCH.


PLEASE NOTE: THE RUBBER BASE SEAL IS AN ESSENTIAL ITEM AND MUST BE FITTED TO THE UNDERSIDE OF THE TAP BASE.



- IF KITCHEN TAP IS SUPPLIED WITH PULL DOWN WAND, YOU WILL NEED TO REMOVE THE CONNECTOR ASSEMBLY - SEE IMAGE. THERE WILL BE A BRASS TUBE PROTRUDING OUT OF THE BOTTOM OF THE SHANK. ITS IMPORTANT NOT TO DAMAGE THE END OF THIS TUBE **DURING INSTALLATION.**
- ON PULL DOWN TAP, ASSEMBLE CENTRE UNION ONTO THE BODY OF THE TAP. THE UNION SHOULD JUST SLIDE ON, WET O-RING TO HELP ASSEMBLY.
- PLEASE REFER TO THE FRONT IMAGE FOR DIMENSIONAL POSITIONING OF PULL DOWN TAP ON WORKTOP.
- FEED THE PULL DOWN HOSE THROUGH THE SPOUT AND EXIT UNDERNEATH THE WORKTOP. LOOSEN THE BRASS WEIGHT BY UNSCREWING THE 2-HALVES - DO NOT COMPLETLY UNSCREW.
- SLIDE HOSE THROUGH BRASS WEIGHT AND SECURE TOGETHER BY SCREWING TIGHT THE 2-HALVES OF THE BRASS WEIGHT TOGETHER.
- THE RECOMMENDED POSITION TO ATTACH THE WEIGHT IS SHOWN WITH A TAPE GUIDE. CHECK IF THE REACH OF THE PULL DOWN IS SUFFICIENT / ADJUST TO SUIT.



• ENSURE WASHER A IS IN POSITION INSIDE CAPTIVE NUT, SLIDE CONNECTOR ASSEMBLY OVER BRASS TUBE ONTO COLD SHANK SIDE FULLY TIGHTEN CAPTIVE NUT ONTO COLD SIDE, ENSURE THE PUSH-FIT HOSE DOES NOT TWIST IN THE PROCESS.

• ONCE THE CONNECTOR ASSEMBLY IS FULLY TIGHTENED ONTO SHANK CAPTURING WASHER A, TIGHTEN THE BOTTOM GLAND NUT ON THE CONNECTOR ASSEMBLY TO FULLY COMPRESS INTERNAL O-RINGS SEALS ONTO BRASS TUBE.

• ENSURE BRASS WEIGHT IS IN POSITION ON PULLDOWN HOSE. PUSH THE PULL DOWN HOSE INTO THE PUSH-FIT HOSE AS SHOWN.

• Ensure Wand hose is free to move and returns to its home POSITION. IF THE HOSES CLASH, LOOSEN THE CAPTIVE NUT AND ROTATE THE CONNECTOR ASSEMBLY AWAY FROM THE WAND HOSE. ONCE THE DESIRED POSITION IS GOOD AND HOSE IS FREE TO MOVE. TIGHTEN THE CAPTIVE NUT. SEE IMAGE BELOW IN STEP 4.
